The Tabor Sports Hall is a modern sports facility with a well-equipped bowling centre featuring six lanes, suitable for international competitions. The venue offers changing rooms, a spectator area and convenient parking facilities.

3. Disciplines

In accordance with the EDSO Technical Regulations (2026), the following disciplines will be contested:

- Team Competition (Men and Women)
- Individual Competition (Men and Women)
- Mixed Tandem (Men/Women)
- Combination

Detailed competition rules are specified in the official document "EDSO Technical Regulations – Ninepin Bowling 2026" and are in accordance with the regulations of the WNBA–NBC (World Ninepin Bowling Association – Classic).

4. Applications and Deadlines

Preliminary application: The submission deadline was 30 October 2025. Several countries have already submitted their applications.

Final application: by 21 February 2026

Nominal application: by 21 April 2026

5. Accommodation

Each team is responsible for arranging their own accommodation in Maribor. The organizer will not handle bookings.

We recommend that teams make reservations as soon as possible, preferably in hotels near Tabor Hall (e.g., Hotel City, Hotel Arena, Hotel Tabor).

It does not have to be a hotel – apartments, hostels, or other suitable accommodations are also acceptable.

6. Transportation

Transportation between Graz Airport (Austria) and Maribor, as well as between hotels and Tabor Hall, must be arranged individually by each team. Each team is also responsible for transportation to any other locations if needed.

7. Visa Information

Some countries require a visa to enter Slovenia.

Participants who need an official invitation from the organizer should contact the Slovenian Deaf Sports Association (ŠZGS) no later than March 2026.
